- School-wide performances for parents and students








PERSONALIZED LEARNING

Our Personalized Learning (PL) classes are adaptive learning opportunities to support the needs of our students, primarily in math and language arts. Classroom teachers, along with an instructional aide, work with students from their own grade level, which provides deeper knowledge of grade level content standards, as well as the ability to provide intervention support within their project, if appropriate. Teacher recommendations help identify students who need the extra support and teachers use STAR 360 math and literacy data to drive their instructional planning.





ENRICHMENT CLASSES

We believe that students are most successful when they explore new skills, face challenges in a variety of settings, and are able to practice persistence outside the classroom. Our enrichment classes provide students the chance to try something new or improve on skills they already have. Ultimately, we want our kids to have the ability to learn with their peers and collaborate with students in different classes and grade levels. Classes offered are: Folkloric Dance, Soccer (Boys and Girls), Basketball (Boys and Girls), Hip Hop Dance, Stitch Club, Leaders For Success, Urban Art, Robotics, Claymation, Fitness, Garden, Geniuses, Spanish, Poetry, and African Drums.



LEARNING CAFE MENU OF CLASSES:

Personalized Learning- Assessment based, personalized academic instruction

Fitness Room- Improved physical fitness using resistance training and cardiovascular activities

Basketball- Development of dribbling, passing and shooting skills leading to complete games

Soccer- Basic dribbling and passing skills

African Drums- Learn basic rhythms and techniques to play traditional African music

Hip-Hop Dance- Use basic hip-hip dance moves to create a complex hip-hop dance routine

Poetry- Introduction to creative writing

Folkloric Dance-Learn traditional Mexican dance techniques

Urban Art- Apply drawing techniques and new media to projects

Stitch Club- Use simple stitch work to create garments and bags

Spanish-Introduction to everyday Spanish

Garden- Learn about proper care and gardening techniques of the K. Smith garden

Clay Animation - Clay models are used to create stop motion movies

Robotics- Learn to program simple robots to move around obstacles




